### Anzac Day

Kongorong Primary School and CPC Student Representatives attended the 102<sup>nd</sup> Dawn and Morning Anzac Day Commemorative Services in Mount Gambier. Anzac Day, April 25<sup>th</sup> 2017, marked the 102<sup>nd</sup> anniversary of the Anzac landing at Anzac Cove, the beginning of an eight month campaign in which 50,000 Australians fought, 8700 lost their lives and almost 18,000 were wounded. We were among 14 other schools in the Partnerships that attended the Dawn Service and laid wreaths to honour the bravery, mateship and sacrifice of the men and women who defended the nation's freedom and values. Brianna, Emily and Dakota attended the services on the day. The Kongorong Sportsman's Club also had a strong contingency at the Dawn Service and laid a wreath.

We also marked the important occasion by holding our own School Anzac Day Commemorative Service.
