Thank you to the Governing Council for all the work they have done and will continue to do in looking after the school.

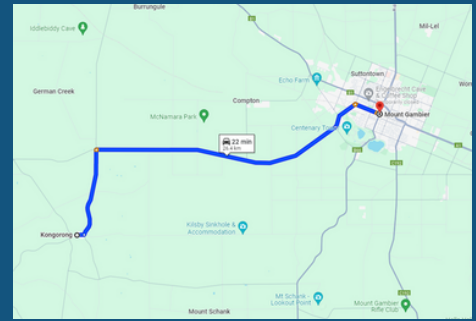
